Sample responses (answers may vary slightly):

Student A: What do I need to do to enrol on the computer graphics course?

Student B: The first thing you need to do is fill in an enrolment form.

Student A: Where do I get the enrolment form?

Student B: It's an online form and it's on our website.

Student A: How much does the course cost?

Student B: The course costs 600 euros.

Student A: What do I need to do to get a place on the course?

Student B: You have to pay a deposit of 100 euros.

Student A: Do I need any qualifications for the course?

Student B: The only qualifications that are needed are basic computer skills.

Student A: How long does the course last?

Student B: The course lasts 6 weeks.

Student A: Who is the teacher for the course?

Student B: The course teacher is a professional in computer graphics.

Student A: How many students are on the course?

Student B: There are 35 students on the course.

Student A: What books do I need for the course?

Student B: There is one course book to buy.

Student A: How much does the course book cost?

Student B: It costs 40 euros.

Student B: What do I have to do to enrol on the Chinese language course?

Student A: First of all, you have to apply for the enrolment form.

Student B: How do I receive the enrolment form?

Student A: Once you've applied for it, we send it to your address.

Student B: How much does the course cost?

Student A: The course costs 800 euros.
