

Communicative worksheet

Making a presentation

1 Ask students to look at the calendar. Establish that these days are special days recognised by the United Nations. Ask students:

Do you celebrate these days?

What do you do?

What do you think people do on these days?

What do people think about on these days?

Do you think they are important? Why?

2 Hand out the student cards. Ask students to work in pairs to put the phrases in order. Ask students to practise saying the phrases.

Answers:

2, 4, 3, 1

3 Ask pairs to choose a day to talk about and to prepare phrases they could use in their presentation. If students have internet access, they could research pictures and ideas about the special days on the Internet.

Alternatively, ask them to use their imagination to prepare things to talk about. Monitor and help with ideas and vocabulary.

4 Ask students to come to the front of the class and make their presentation individually or in pairs.

Ask the class to listen and to think of a question to ask the speaker about the special day in their presentation.

5 Personalise

Ask students to think of a time when they made a presentation. Ask:

What did you talk about?

How did you feel?

6 Writing

Ask students to write up their presentations.
